7. Ensure a safe, supportive, and ragging-free environment for all students.

Tenure

The Committee shall function as an Interim Anti-Ragging Committee from the date of issuance of this order and shall continue until a regular Anti-Ragging Committee is duly constituted by the competent authority or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Agenda

1. Introduction of the Interim Anti-Ragging Committee.
2. Formulation of anti-ragging measures for the institution.
3. Establishment of complaint reporting and monitoring mechanisms.

Proceedings

The meeting commenced with the Chairperson welcoming all members and emphasizing the institution's commitment to maintaining a ragging-free campus. The purpose and responsibilities of the Interim Anti-Ragging Committee were explained to the members.

After discussion, the following resolutions were adopted:

1. The Committee resolved to implement a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging in any form within the college campus, hospital premises, hostels, and associated facilities.
2. It was decided that anti-ragging awareness programmes, orientation sessions, and interactive meetings would be conducted for all newly admitted students at the beginning of the academic session.
3. The Committee resolved to prominently display anti-ragging notices, helpline numbers, and contact details of committee members at strategic locations within the institution and hostels.
4. Members discussed mechanisms for receiving complaints and resolved to ensure prompt, fair, and confidential handling of all complaints related to ragging.
5. Regular monitoring of hostels, common areas, classrooms, and campus premises shall be undertaken to prevent incidents of ragging.

6. Faculty members, hostel wardens, security personnel, and student representatives shall be sensitized regarding their role in preventing and reporting ragging.
7. The Committee reviewed the applicable anti-ragging regulations and resolved to recommend strict disciplinary action against any individual found involved in ragging activities.
8. The Committee noted that no incident of ragging had been reported during the period under review.

Conclusion

The members reiterated their commitment to creating a safe, supportive, and welcoming environment for all students. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
