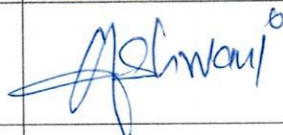
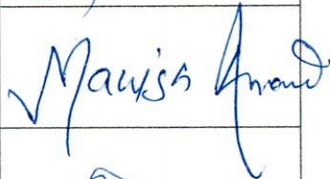
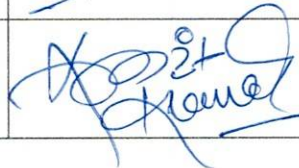
CONSTITUTION OF INTERIM CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

6. Monitoring academic progress of students and recommending remedial measures where required.
7. Collecting and reviewing student feedback for continuous academic improvement.
8. Ensuring timely completion of syllabus and adherence to academic standards.

Tenure:

The Committee shall function as an interim body until the regular Curriculum Committee is constituted or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Agenda

Proceedings

The meeting commenced with the Chairperson welcoming all members and highlighting the importance of a structured curriculum for ensuring quality medical education. The Committee was informed that it would function until the regular Curriculum Committee is formally constituted.

After detailed discussion, the following resolutions were adopted:

1. The Committee resolved to oversee the effective implementation of the competency-based medical education (CBME) curriculum in accordance with the applicable regulatory guidelines.
2. All departments were advised to prepare and adhere to their teaching schedules, lesson plans, and academic activities as per the approved academic calendar.

3. The Committee emphasized the importance of integrated and interdisciplinary teaching and resolved to encourage coordination among pre-clinical, para-clinical, and clinical departments.
4. It was decided to monitor the conduct of lectures, practical sessions, tutorials, clinical postings, and self-directed learning activities to ensure timely completion of the curriculum.
5. The Committee reviewed the framework for formative and summative assessments and resolved to ensure transparency, fairness, and timely evaluation of students.
6. Student feedback regarding teaching-learning activities shall be collected periodically and utilized for continuous improvement of the curriculum delivery process.
7. The Committee resolved to promote innovative teaching-learning methods, including small-group discussions, skill-based training, simulation-based learning, and e-learning resources.
8. Departments were encouraged to identify and address academic gaps through remedial classes, mentoring, and additional academic support for students.
9. The Committee decided to meet periodically to review curriculum implementation, academic progress, and compliance with regulatory requirements.
